On behalf of the Government of the Republic of Namibia, the Environmental Investment Fund, Climate Fund Managers and Invest International, we would be honoured to have your presence at a presentation of the SDG Namibia One Fund, an exciting initiative focused on the green hydrogen ecosystem in Namibia.

Designed as an innovative blended finance platform, SDG Namibia One Fund will provide private sector developers access to capital from an early stage of development, and then throughout the subsequent stages of implementation of the project, enabling predictability of funding and continuity of development momentum.

SDG Namibia One Fund will be managed by NH2 Fund Managers, a partnership between the Environmental Investment Fund of Namibia (owned by the Namibian Government), Climate Fund Managers and Invest International from the Netherlands. Invest International will act as an anchor investor in the fund with a commitment of 40 Million Euros of development capital supporting a first closing of the fund by Q1 2023.

SDG Namibia One Fund is targeting a final close of One (1) Billion Euros and will invest across the value chain of the Namibian Green Hydrogen sector. Grounded in a quadruple bottom line investment ethos, the SDG Namibia One Fund will ensure that national strategic objectives are obtained whilst delivering social, environmental, financial, and economic transformation dividends across the Green Hydrogen sector.
